PREFACE

This report, Part 1 Whole Japan of Vol. 4 "Results of Detailed Tabulation (Twenty-Percent Sample Tabulation)", is to complement the results of the complete-count tabulation of the 1980 Population Census of Japan which have already been published as Vol. 1 "Total Population", Vol. 2 "Results of the First Basic Complete Tabulation", Vol. 3 "Results of the Second Basic Complete Tabulation", etc., by sampling one-fifth (20%) of the total households and providing more detailed tables on occupation, industry and multi-cross-classified tabulation.

The results of Detailed Tabulation are compiled as follows, and this report is "Vol. 4 Part 1 Whole Japan, Div. 3".

- Vol. 4: Results of Detailed Tabulation (Twenty-Percent Sample Tabulation)
 - Part 1 Whole Japan (3 separate divisions)
 - Div. 1 Labour Force Status, Industry, Occupation, Employment Status
 - Div. 2 Socio-Economic Groups, Time of Last Move, Previous Residence, Level of Education, Family Type of Household, Economic Type of Household, Source of Household Income
 - Div. 3 Housing, Labour Force Status of Couple, Mother and Own Children
 - Part 2 Prefectures (47 separate parts)
 - 01 Hokkaido - 47 Okinawa-ken
- Vol. 5: Commutation
 - Part 3 Place of Work or Schooling of Population by Industry and Occupation (Medium Groups)
- Vol. 6: Results of Tabulation on Internal Migration
 - Part 3 Migrants and Their Households

Of the above, Part 2 Prefectures of Vol. 4 have been released successively, prefecture by prefecture, and Div. 1 and 2 of Part 1 Whole Japan of Vol. 4 have been published at the same time with this report. Part 3 of Vol. 5 and Part 3 of Vol. 6 are also scheduled to be published.

The figures in these reports are subject to sampling errors as they are the estimates based on a sample tabulation. In using these results-figures, it is necessary to give a careful consideration on the degree of sampling errors, by referring to "Method of Sample Tabulation and Reliability of Estimates" presented in this report.

I hope this report will be very helpful to users in combination with the reports already published.
