Please Read The Following Notes Before Filling Out

1 Around <u>Time Day Month</u> the census enumerator will call on you to pick up this questionnaire. Please fill out, by that time, the columns designated as "TO BE FILLED OUT BY HEAD OF HOUSEHOLD" on the entry page and the "MEMO" column on p. 3. As the columns "TO BE FILLED OUT BY ENUMERATOR" are to be entered by the enumerator himself upon interview, these columns are requested to be left blank.

2 This questionnaire is requested to be filled out separately for each household. Special attention is to be paid in the following cases.

Lodgers:

- Lodgers such as roomers and boarders shall be reported individually as a separate household.
 Lodgers living with their relatives shall be reported with their relatives in one group as one
- household.
- O Persons living in school dormitorics, dormitories for unmarried employees, etc. shall be reported together in one group as one household.

Live-in Employees [those living together with employers]:

- O All live-in employees for domesticities shall be reported together with the families of their employees.
- O Live-in employees for business shall be reported together with the families of their employers in case of five employees or less, and together with themselves in one group as a separate household in case of six employees or more.
- 3 ALL MEMBERS WHO USUALLY LIVE in your household are to be included in this questionnaire. The term "usually live" means that these persons have lived or are going to live in your household for three months or more.

Special attention is to be paid in the following cases,

- Persons who have been away from their households due to travelling or working elsewhere shall be reported at their homes if they have been away for less than three months.
- Students and pupils living in school dormitories shall be reported at the dormitories, not at their homes.

Hospitalized patients shall be reported at the hospitals if they have been there for more than three months. If not, they shall be reported at their homes.

Crews of ships shall be reported at their homes.

- All residents of camps and of ships belonging to the National Defence Forces shall be reported at the camps or on the ships, not at their homes.
- Persons in prisons or detention houses whose penalties have been fixed, and persons in reformatories or woman's guidance homes shall be reported at the institutions.
- Persons having no places where they have lived or are going to live for more than three months shall be reported at the places where they stay at the time of census,
