Green tourism

Development of sixth sector industrialization

An effort to increase an income by creating employment utilizing the local resources, which uses and integrally processes and sells the agricultural, <u>forest and fishery products</u> and the by-product thereof (biomass, etc.). Specifically, it refers to a diversified and composite management such as direct sales, processing and export of local agricultural product.

Effort in the development of renewable energy

It refers to an effort in the development of renewable energy utilizing the local resources. For example, it is an effort in placing solar power generation panel in the diverted land of agricultural land and forest land and placing a power generation facility in the agricultural irrigation and drainage canal.
