Please make sure that the Schedule has been filled up accurately and then insert the Reporter's Name in column "Reporter's Name" and stamp the Reporter's Seal in column "Seal".

The head or the actual manager of the household is requested to fill up the Schedule before 8 a. m. on the 1st day of October and hand it to the Census-enumerator when he calls to collect it.

Form with multiple columns for personal and household information, including name, sex, date of birth, marital status, and business details. Includes a table for 'Specified Talent' and 'Specified School-Career'.

Instructions for Making Entries

- 1. The entry of the Schedule should be made in sumi or in blue-black ink, and in legible characters.
2. Never write "The same as above" or any similar expression, but repeat the same statement in full as many times as it may occur.
3. If you have made a mistake in filling up the Schedule, draw a line across the wrong entry, and insert the correction by the side.

Persons to Be Included in the Schedule

- (a) Every person who is present in the dwelling of the household at Census time...
(b) A person who at Census time happens to be out of his house or at some place where there is no household, for night work, night service, or otherwise...
(c) A person of whom it is previously known that he will be travelling at Census time...

How to Fill Up the Schedule

- 1. Name
2. In case the real name is unknown, enter the name by which the person is generally known.
3. Status in the Household
4. Sex
5. Date of Birth
6. Condition as to Marriage
7. Industry in which the Person is Engaged and Occupation he Follows
8. Condition as to Military or Naval Service
9. Birthplace
10. Domicile
11. Race or Nationality

- 2. If the business-establishment carries on only one kind of business, draw an oblique line across the blank space.
3. If the person is a maidservant, nurse-maid, chauffeur, or the like, hired for domestic service, draw an oblique line across the blank space.
4. If the person has no occupation, draw an oblique line across the blank space.
