## PREFACE

This is the first volume of the Report of the Population Census of 1960. This volume presents the total count of population of Japan by geographical divisions, obtained from the Census taken as of October 1, 1960.

The Population Census of 1960 was the ninth census in Japan, the first census being taken in 1920, and the third regular census after the war. As for the enumeration items, they include not only such basic characteristics of population as relationship to the household head, sex, date of birth, marital status and legal nationality, but also migration, education, fertility of women, economic characteristics (type of activity, industry, occupation, status and place of work, etc.), and household and housing status. The results of the enumeration are now under the tabulation procedure in one percent sampling, complete counting and ten percent sampling, and they will be released in succeeding volumes as soon as they are ready.

This volume also presents the land area for all Japan and its geographical divisions. We acknowledge the kindness shown us by the Geographical Survey Institute, Ministry of Construction, for the preparation of these figures.

We wish to express our sincere gratitude to many people for their hearty cooperation with us throughout the work of this Census, from its planning and field work stage to the compilation of the results.
