PREFACE

The population census has been carried out every five years since 1920 when the first population census was taken.

The 1970 population census was the tenth one which was conducted after the lapse of 50 years from the first population census of 1920.

The 1970 population census was carried out in Okinawa at the same time and by using the same form of questionnaires as in Japan with the understanding that report forms would be the same as those likewise adopted in Japan: and the tabulation of the data collected was undertaken by the Bureau of Statistics, Prime Minister's Office.

This report contains the tabulated basic data concerning population by sex, age, spouse, nationality, educational level, labour force, industry, occupation, employment status and family, etc. and is identical in contents with "Report of the 1970 Population Census: Volume III; Prefecture and Municipalities".

By the bye, in addition to this report, "Population of Okinawa" will be compiled and published with tables showing ratios between the important figures taken for Okinawa and for municipalities, comparisons of the new figures with the old ones and some complementary explanations as to them in contents.

Now that this report is issued, I wish to take this opportunity to express my hearty thanks to the Bureau of Statistics, Prime Minister's Office, those persons concerned of municipal governments and all of the people of Okinawa Prefecture for the kind cooperation they had given in the laying and carrying-out of the population census.
