The letters of A, P, L, M, and W described above are the codes of the areal divisions for statistical presentation as shown as follows:

A refers to the entire country, all *shi* and all *gun* of the country.
P refers to prefectures (*To, Do, Fu* or *Ken*), all *shi* and all *gun* within the prefecture

L refers to 7 largest cities (*Ku*-area of *Tokyo-to*, *Yokohama-shi*, *Nagoya-shi*, *Kyoto-shi*, *Osaka-shi*, *Kobe-shi* and *Kitakyushu-shi*)

M refers to *shi*, *ku*, *machi*, or *mura*.

W refers to *shi* and *ku*

* includes the densely inhabited districts (D.I.D.s).

† excludes all *shi* and all *gun*
