

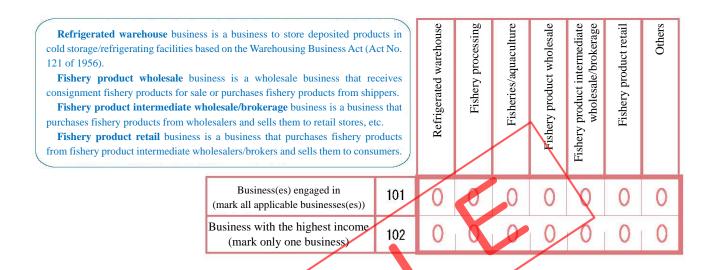

- [1] Individual business owner or family member who works without pay
- [2] Paid executive (person covered by the executive pay/remuneration system)
- [3] Employee (person who receives wage/salary including payment in kind)
 - Person in an executive position but covered by the same wage/salary system as employees, not the executive pay/remuneration system
 - Person who is engaged for an undetermined period
 - Person who is engaged for a period of one month or more
- [4] Person who is engaged through transfer or dispatchPerson who is engaged for a period of one month or more

Employee is a full-time worker who fall under [3] "Employee."

- **Other** is a worker other than full-time worker.
- Person engaged in duties for a time period set to less than one month
- Person hired on a daily basis (day worker), etc.





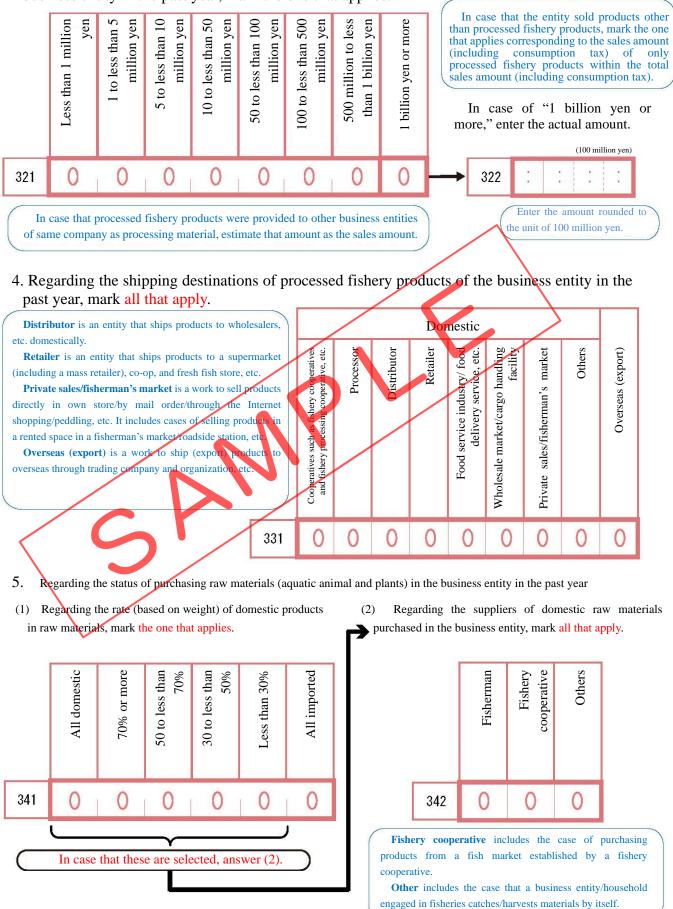
